## Small Group Discussion Guide

In part three of this series, we heard the story of a local survivor of human trafficking. Belma found herself with little options in domestic servitude in Corvallis,. Her story is a powerful example of injustice and the work we can do as believers to bring justice.

### Discussion Questions

1. What stood out to you the most about the story of Belma?
2. What did you learn about God while you heard the story of Belma?
3. What did you learn about justice from the story?
4. Pastor Bryan asked us to listen for examples of a generous justice. In what ways was extravagant generosity offered?
5. Justice is not just an act of a single individual but the collective work of the church. In what ways can we work in Corvallis to do justice together?

Consider the passage in Amos that was shared: **Amos 5:21-24**

6. What do these verses mean for the church today?
7. Is it possible to experience complete justice in this lifetime?
8. Justice for the oppressed is at the heart of God, why do you think the church historically has failed to bring justice to the oppressed?
